AMSOIL Dual Remote Filtration System

There was a ton of room between the front bumper and the radiator to accommodate the AMSOIL Dual Remote Filtration System (BMK23). We removed the front license plate bracket to help with the installation. We then fabricated a bracket and drilled holes in it that align with the holes already behind the bumper. We mounted the bracket and installed the filters and ran the lines to the engine block original equipment manufacturer (OEM) filter installation. We also ended up making a small support bracket to remove the small amount of vibration present. It took us about 2 hours to fabricate and install, and works well.



Installing the Dual Remote Filtration System (BMK23) behind the front bumper leaves enough room for a 10" by-pass filter.



A self-fabricated bracket holds the filter manifold.



The 2009 Ford F-150 offers plenty of room for straight-forward installation between the front bumper and radiator.
