



It was an easy installation on this truck and this customer will now be installing more of these on other trucks.

Brown Distributing, the Budweiser Beer Distributor in central Texas, just installed its first AMSOIL Heavy-Duty By-Pass Filtration System (BMK30) on a 2010 IH Trans Star Model 8600 SBA 6 X 4 with a Cummins ISX engine and an Allison automatic transmission. This truck will be heavily-loaded, up to about 40,000 pounds in the trailer.

One interesting item on this installation is the way the oil was returned to the engine. Note that a fitting was welded into the oil fill tube about 4" from the engine and 10" below the oil fill cap. The hoses follow along the frame for about 5' since the unit is mounted behind the cab using a bracket mounted directly to the frame. This is a very sturdy bracket made from 3/8" steel plate welded in an "L" shape. No holes were drilled in the frame, some existing holes were used to bolt the mounting plate to the frame.

This brand new Cummins ISX engine runs AMSOIL Premium CJ-4 Synthetic 15W-40 Diesel Oil (DME), an AMSOIL EaBP120 By-Pass Oil Filter and a Donaldson Endurance Full-Flow Oil Filter for maximum protection.
